For the church community at Holy Trinity Church, Macclesfield, a new community hub on the church's grounds was needed but had to be tastefully added to a holy site that is around 200 years old.

The church advised they were fairly constrained with what they were allowed to build due to the nature of the site and so a modular route was chosen because it didn't need a full concrete foundation.

THE PROJECT

The evangelical Church of England's community in Hurdsfield, Macclesfield approached Elite Systems GB through a contractor to provide the vibrant new building on their historical grounds.

As part of their plans to consistently work within their community to provide events such as youth groups, smokers support sessions, as well as working with local NHS trusts to provide health drop-in sessions, the need for additional space became paramount.

The new functioning space was made through collaborative works and the modules craned and installed in less than a day, with work finished a few weeks later.

THE RESULTS

We built a 7.3 x 18.6m hub complete with the main hall, kitchen, toilets, and office.

The external finish of wooden cladding combined with turquoise aluminium doors and windows created a vibrant and welcoming aesthetic, complementing the nearby foliage and stone church.



The main features - inside and out

- Large hall with two sets of double doors leading to decking
- Wooden cladded exterior as a feature
- Fully functional kitchen with white goods, and rear office
- Integrated air conditioning
